## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: ESTABLISH NAS3306 AIRCRAFT RESCUE AND FIRE FIGHTING (ARFF)

PROTECTION LEVEL FOR THE B-21 AIRCRAFT

REFERENCE: NAS3306, "Facility Requirements for Aircraft Operations," May 29, 2020

The purpose of this memorandum is to establish the NAS3306 ARFF protection level for the B-21 aircraft as ARFF Category 7.

This determination was made in coordination with the Air Force (AV3 and AFLCMC/EZVP) as the procuring Service. This aircraft is very similar to the B-2 and does not fit well into the normal ARFF methodology for categorizing aircraft. The B-21 is slightly smaller than the B-2 with a lower fuel capacity; however, the construction materials and strategic importance of the aircraft are very similar. Based on these factors and the wing area of the B-21, the determination is to keep the B-21 at the same ARFF Category 7 protection level as the B-2.
